The Events



Set against the backdrop of the Sierra Nevada and Lake Tahoe, 5 concerts will comprise the festival (North Shore, West Shore and Truckee), that features 20 young musicians who are embarking on their professional careers. These musicians are products of the Festival's Orchestral Academy. This program conducted by Maestro Timm Rolek, brings students together with professional artists to advance their musical and performance skills culminating in the Music Festival "Sunset Serenades" a classical music series of concerts.

Classical music will be celebrated on the beautiful lake and at pastoral venues around the community. Each intimate outdoor venue is specially designed with an acoustical concert in mind and will offer pure sound from instruments – without amplification.

- ❖ **Orchestral Academy** – This program will allow 20 young musicians who are about to embark on their professional careers to train with current working professional musicians during the 10 day academy . These young musicians will in turn perform at 5 different venues in North Lake Tahoe and Truckee . The families and community members of North Lake Tahoe and Truckee will have the opportunity to enjoy the wonderful classical music provided by these student concerts at the summers – Serenades and Sunset – concerts in outdoor venues around Tahoe and Truckee.
- ❖ **The Music Mentoring program at Tahoe Truckee schools** – older students under the guidance of a music teacher funded by this program mentor young musicians . The Lake Tahoe Music Festival has funded this mentoring program for over 20 years in our community and with your assistance hopes to continue it for many years to come.

Results and Accountability

- 1- Measure and report how many students we are able to accommodate and train in our Orchestral Academy each year and detail their professional progress post academy.
- 2- Measure and poll the audiences of our Sunset Serenades concert series to measure how many local residents and visitors are attending these events and their assessment of the music and venues.
3. Measure growth of our mentoring program and the number of community children participating. Share student, teacher and parental assessments of the program with donors and sponsors.
